

EDUCATIONAL EVALUATION AND RESEARCH (M.ED.)

Admission Requirements

Students are admitted every semester and must meet the general admission requirements for the Master of Education (<http://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/college-education/academic-regulations/education-masters-degrees/>).

A minimum of thirty credits is required for this degree under Plan A, B, or C. Required courses include ED 7999 if Plan B or C is elected, or ED 8999 for Plan A. In addition, a minimum of twelve credits in educational evaluation and research. All course work must be completed in accordance with the academic procedures of the College of Education (<http://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/college-education/academic-regulations/>) and the Graduate School's (<http://bulletins.wayne.edu/graduate/general-information/degree-certificate-requirements/>) regulations governing graduate scholarship and degrees.
